Neighborhood Cache

 A Neighborhood Cache is a collection of tools and supplies that are shared within a neighborhood.


 The Cache can be stored in a central location or in an individual's home but it needs to be accessible to at least several people at all times.


 A Cache will contain items that are appropriate for the neighborhood. Frequent items include a Pop-up shelter with walls, lighting, generator, hard hats, work gloves, axe, shovels, pry bars, caution tape, duct tape, flashlights, batteries, forms, fire extinguishers, portable toilet, etc.

Neighborhood Cache

 A Neighborhood Cache is frequently stored in a large job box as might be found on the back of a pickup or it can be a watertight shed.

 Having the box on wheels makes it easy to use following a disaster but it also makes it easy to steal.

 Make sure that it is locked and it is best to have video surveillance. The contents are not only valuable, they need to be there when they are needed.

 If you have electronics, make sure you have power available to keep them charged.
