- Personal safety is ALWAYS the number one priority
- Show up prepared
 - > Wear appropriate clothing and footwear, have WATER
 - ➤ Wear PPE your personal protective equipment ...gloves, helmet, goggles, mask, boots, etc.
 - > Have at least one communications device: cell, radio, etc.
- Work as a team
- Size-up maintain situational awareness
- The CERT goal is to do the Greatest Good for the Greatest Number
- Hope for the best but plan for the worst!

What is terrorism?

"the threatened or actual use of illegal force and violence by a non-state actor to attain a political, economic, religious, or social goal through fear, coercion, or intimidation"

- Recognizes the psychological impact it has on a society for many years
- Must be intended to coerce, intimidate, or convey some other message to a larger audience other than to the immediate victims
- Outside the precepts of international

humanitarian law



Potential Indicators of Terrorism

- Look for unusual/suspicious behavior out of the ordinary events or items
 - > Unattended bags or leaking packages
 - > People not dressed for the situation
 - > People taking pictures of security arrangements

CBRNE Indicators

Chemical, Biological, Radiological, Nuclear, Explosive (CBRNE) Indicators


- Vapor clouds or mists that are unusual for the area or for the time of day
- Out of place and unattended packages, boxes, or vehicles
- Multiple victims exhibiting similar symptoms
- If you observe any indicators
 - > Do not touch
 - Move away
 - Report it

If You See Indicators IF YOU FIND A SUSPICIOUS PACKAGE: Do not touch it! Move away from the object Report it to authorities Caution: Using cellular phones or two-way radios may detonate an explosive device!

Shelter-in-Place Procedures

- Shut off ventilation systems
- Go to your shelter-in-place room
- Use precut plastic sheeting to cover air openings
- Tape sheeting over doors, windows, vents
- Use duct tape to seal other areas
- Listen to a battery-powered radio
- Ventilate room once contaminants are gone

Until Help Arrives

- CERT volunteers are NOT equipped or trained to respond to terrorist incidents
- If you find yourself in a situation that you believe to be a terrorist attack, focus on the most lifesaving interventions:
 - > Move those in grave danger to a safe place
 - > Open airway
 - Stop bleeding
 - > Prevent shock
- Consider the impacts of stress & fear on yourself and others
- Be alert to the possibility of a second coordinated attack

Basic Personal Decontamination Procedures

- Leave the immediate contaminated area
- Take decontamination action
 - Remove everything
 - > Wash hands before using them to shower
 - > Shower or flush with cool water
 - ➤ Blot dry
- Report for professional decontamination

What Professional Responders Will Do

Follow size-up steps

- > What is going on?
- > How bad is the situation and how much worse could it get?
- > Is there a possibility of a secondary attack
- What measures can be taken to control the incident safely?
- > What resources will be needed?

Active Shooter

Run

> If there is an accessible escape path, attempt to evacuate the premises


Hide


> If evacuation is not possible, find a place to hide where the active shooter is less likely to find you


Fight

If you are unable to run, evacuate or hide and when your life is in imminent danger, you may attempt to disrupt and/or incapacitate the active shooter

Takeaways

- When terrorists attack, their goals are to:
 - > Create mass casualties
 - > Disrupt critical resources, vital services, and the economy
 - > Cause widespread fear
 - > STAY CALM
- Terrorism is old but some tactics are new
 - Active Shooter
 - > Vehicles
 - > Improvised Explosive Devices
 - > Complex Coordinated Attacks
 - > Cyber Attacks
 - · BE ALERT: If you see something Say Something
